We're having a Picnic!

11:45 to 2pm.

The Management team, with the assistance of the Town of Hanover's "Return to Play" officer, has obtained a permit to hold a picnic! Due to the pandemic, there are a number of guidelines to be followed to ensure everyone's safety. Please read carefully.



What to Bring:

Lawn chair, your lunch and beverage. Hand sanitizer and mask for when you need to move around. There is a covered area at the pavilion, but with social distancing, it will accommodate approximately 27 people, so bring a sun hat, and shades if it's sunny, or a lap blanket if there is a chill in the air!

1. Participants should wear a face mask when they arrive, until they have settled into the spot where they will enjoy their lunch. Please follow social distancing guidelines while moving about.
2. Pylons/ chalk marks and volunteers will assist individuals and households establishing lunch spots 2 meters apart.
3. There are a limited number of picnic tables available that can be used by individuals or households. Be aware that these are not sanitized, however.
4. The pavilion washrooms are available. These will be clean and sanitized upon our arrival but will not be sanitized or cleaned throughout the picnic. You are advised to bring your own hand sanitizer.
5. The town of Hanover garbage cans are available; however, we encourage you to bring your lunch in recyclable containers that can go home with you. If you use the garbage cans please social distance.
6. All attendees are expected to perform a self-assessment prior to attending. Please do not attend if you are feeling ill or have any symptoms relate to COVID 19.
7. Please do not share rides to the picnic with anyone outside of your bubble.
8. You must indicate you interest in attending prior to the picnic. Ontario law limits the number of people attending an outdoor event to 100 people. Should we have a very large number of people interested in attending, we may consider holding a second event.
9. Your response to the invitation will form our contact list for tracing purposes should the need ever arise. The list would only be disclosed to the medical officer of health or an Inspector under the Health Protection and Promotion Act on request for a purpose specified in section 2 of that Act.
10. **Please reply to the invitation email, stating that you have read this PROBUS picnic protocol and agree to abide by the guidelines. Also indicate the number of people attending. We will use this as confirmation as our contact list.**
